Suicide attack kills at least 7 in eastern Afghanistan

USPA News - At least seven people died after a suicide bomb attack on Wednesday in eastern Afghanistan, officials said. The attack took place on Wednesday evening in the district of Moqor in Afghanistan's eastern province of Ghazni, when a suicide bomber detonated explosives, apparently targeting anit-Taliban forces.

Deputy provincial governor Mohammad Ali Ahmadi confirmed the deaths of seven people, adding that both Afghan civilians and anti-Taliban uprising forces were among the killed in the attack, according to Khaama Press. In addition, at least thirteen others were also injured. The explosion is Wednesday's second in the province, after at least six others were killed in Ghazni city. No group or terrorist organization has claimed responsibility of the attack.
